RESEARCH POLICY

SJGC is committed to promote research culture in the campus by establishing Research Committee and by implementing research activities by the faculty members through interdepartmental and inter-institutional collaborative research programmes across various programmes offered in the institution namely, Science, Arts and commerce. SJGC ensures that research in all fields is in line with the ethical norms and research standards.

OBJECTIVES

1. To create an outstanding research environment and infrastructure
2. To facilitate inter, multi and trans disciplinary research
3. To publish papers in journals of national and international repute
4. To file patents and transfer technologies to relevant industries
5. To monitor the research outputs continuously by appropriate committees
6. To create quality human resources for scientific research

I. CONSTITUTION OF RESEARCH COMMITTEE:

A Research Committee is constituted to promote the innovative and industrially relevant research to be undertaken by the faculty members of this institution with high quality accuracy and outputs.

The composition of the committee is as follows

1. Principal: Chairperson
2. Coordinator: Member secretary
3. Members: four faculty members
4. Two student representatives

II. RESEARCH ACTIVITIES:

To promote quality of research and to enhance the research output, the institution has launched various research promotion schemes as mentioned below:

Category I: Publications

A. Research Papers in Peer Reviewed /UGC listed Journals: (Faculty of Sciences -08/ Faculty of Other Disciplines – 10 per publication): The Score for joint publications shall be calculated in the following manner: (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for

each author. (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors. Paper presented as part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.

The research activities will be evaluated by the Research Committee and considered annual ASAR score of the faculty.

Annual Self Appraisal Report (ASAR) scores: The publications in research papers in Peer Reviewed /Referred /UGC listed journals, books, Textbooks, research guidance, research projects and consultancy projects are given weightage in Annual Self Appraisal Report scores of the faculty. The ASAR scores are considered for giving promotions under the career advancement scheme CAS and general transfers conducted by the Govt of A.P.

IV. SEED MONEY FOR INTERNAL RESEARCH

- A grant of the research seed money of Rs.3.72 Lakh will be distributed to the full-time faculty members of SJGC, who have submitted project proposals for funding and waiting for the sanction of grant.
- Every faculty is eligible to apply for internal project which shall lead to collaborative / externally funded research projects.
- All proposals received would be evaluated for their quality by a Research committee headed by Principal, recommended applicants will receive the seed grant.
- The Project period is one year from the date of sanction and is expected to be conducted by the faculty.
- Financial Support for Research Paper Presentation in National/ International seminars/conferences
- The colleges shall promote Innovations, Incubation, and Entrepreneurial Development among the teachers and students on MIIC platform.
